To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to inform you that our buildings have been re-inspected in accordance with the U.S. EPA criteria of the Asbestos Hazardous Emergency Response Act (AHERA) (40 CFR Part 763.85 Subpart B). As of July 27, 2009, our buildings do not contain any friable asbestos; therefore, we are in compliance with AHERA regulations. (Friable is defined as “easily crumbled or pulverized.”)

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) regulations require that you be notified every year about the presence of asbestos-containing materials in our buildings; about inspections that we are conducting; any activities that we undertake to repair or remove asbestos materials; and re-inspection plans. Our next re-inspection date will be in July of 2012.

Non-friable asbestos is contained in the floor tile of the Judson Hall lobby, CAIU office, and NILD therapist offices.
